Nurturing the next generation

Nothing's gonna stop us now

"What would happen if that crane fell over?" On the dock at the Port of Blyth, you might encounter team TEXO working to inspire the next generation of young engineers.

Brand Executive Alan Conway is a STEM ambassador. His work includes visiting schools as well as supporting students at Newcastle University, where he provides pre-qualified teachers with life experience. In schools, Alan values the chance to encourage young people into engineering.

"I'll go in and show them the drones and all the equipment, then I'll give them a task like designing something, and tell them if they do well then we'll invite them to the facility," says Alan.

It always seems to work, because "three weeks later we take a minibus down and they come to the facility, we do the risk assessments and the kids put on the PPE – hard hats and hi-vis. We show them around, they get to see the underwater robots, and they love the whole day."

Alan describes watching the kids light up as they're inspired by the scale of the work – and the opportunities that could be theirs. Running up that hill

Ever since he started the TEXO Foundation, it was important to MD Chris Smith that the committee wasn't just handing out cash.

"I've always believed that if you're part of a community, you don't just turn up and take," says Chris. "We give back to people who need a leg-up – and not always monetary; we want to do something different."

The Foundation is an endeavour focused on giving resources to the community, supporting small charities and sometimes simply people who are important to the team.

"Chris does a lot behind the scenes," says Lauren Arnott (DSI Divisional Director). "We hear about issues through our own personal connections, and he's always keen to help."

Lauren's parents are part of the community in the heart of Witham, where they own a pub. Recently a mum in the area lost her battle with cancer. The TEXO Foundation quickly stepped in and supported her two young children – *"they would have been on the street after her death,"* explained Lauren, *"but the Foundation helped with money for a house renovation and furniture, things for the kids."*

"This way, we're giving back to the local community with support where it's needed."

A force for change – time after time

Chris always wants to hear from staff if there are causes or people they'd like to support. This summer there'll be more in the pipeline for the Foundation...

"If our staff want to run or fundraise for one of our charities, we'll match whatever they raise," says Chris. "We've got five locations now and we're building up momentum."

"Obviously there's more we can offer than cash," he points out. "There's a local school wanting to provide cookery lessons, but they don't have the facilities. We're in the planning stages and we want to go in and build them a kitchen during the summer holidays this year."

Chris also told us about an exciting upcoming project for kids in sport. *"I've been talking to Russell Anderson [former captain at AFC], who's built a charity for underprivileged children. Some of them don't have trainers, some of them don't even get breakfast. We're looking at building some Sports Banks where people drop off trainers and t-shirts to help the kids train."*

Dean Sutherland stays undefeated with seventh-round stoppage

Dean Sutherland delivered on his promise of an “explosive performance” earlier this month, stopping Brendon Denes in the seventh round at the Beach Ballroom.

The 24-year-old welterweight prospect dropped Denes with a powerful body shot with 33 seconds remaining in the round, and the Zimbabwean’s corner threw in the towel to spare their man further punishment.

It was Sutherland’s 15th victory, and his first since suffering his first professional defeat last year to Louis Greene.

The Granite City boxer is now looking to build momentum in 2023, and he has another fight night to look forward to in August at Braehead Arena, Glasgow.

The win was Sutherland’s first under new coach Barry Healy, with the boxer now basing himself down in London for his training camps.

This month, more than 40 maths, geography and science trainee teachers had a full day visiting one of TEXO's sites at the Port of Blyth. There was a full presentation and interactive tour of TEXO's live projects and all services that TEXO provides, along with other projects involving local companies based at the port. The trainee teachers had the opportunity to see substantial offshore fabrications and state-of-the-art engineering ranging from subsea ploughs and trenchers, subsea drilling machines, pipe lay towers and vessel mobilisations.
